

Law Skills 4 Criteria

As adopted at April 2, 2014 Faculty Meeting
(Note that original minutes from that meeting were amended
before being approved at next meeting)

- A primary focus of the course must be on teaching lawyering skills through multiple drafting assignments that are practice-oriented.
- A significant portion of student-faculty interaction shall be devoted to the discussion and analysis of those assignments.
- Faculty must give students individualized feedback oriented toward the development of particular lawyering skills.
- The course must be at least two credits. It may be taught by full-time, part-time, or adjunct faculty. Class size will be capped at sixteen students.
