Windows 10 Pro or Home only (Windows 10X and Windows Lite are not

compatible) and Mojave (10.14.6) or newer for Mac.

English language version operating system

Anti-virus software The University of Richmond provides anti-virus software at no cost.

You will be required to install the University's software to access our network.

Equipment/peripherals Extra AC adapter

Three-year, all-inclusive warranty

Homeowner/renter's insurance to cover theft or non-warranty damage

Not permitted as iPad, Chromebook, Kindle Fire, Android mobile device, desktop computer, and any

primary laptop Linux operating system. You cannot use exam software on these devices.
